

**TAX RELIEF FOR ELDERLY OR TOTALLY DISABLED RENTERS  
FILING PERIOD – APRIL 1 – SEPTEMBER 30**

State law provides a program for renters who are over the age of 65 or totally disabled and whose annual income does not exceed certain limits. Under this program a check is sent directly to an approved applicant by the State. To receive a renter rebate:

- An applicant or spouse must be 65 years of age or older OR be 50 years of age or older and the surviving spouse of a renter who at the time his death had qualified and was entitled to tax relief, provided such spouse was domiciled with such renter at the time of his death.
- Or 18 years of age or older and permanently and totally disabled.
- Must have lived in Connecticut for one year.
- Total income for 2025 must be less than \$46,300 unmarried and under \$56,500 married. (income includes social security)

Applications will be accepted through September 30, 2026.

Proof of income and all rent and utility receipts for the calendar year 2025 must be provided when making your application.
